**Story Questions:**

1. What animal did Jesus ask His disciples to bring Him? (a donkey)
2. People waved \_\_\_\_\_ branches and put them on the road when Jesus came? (palm)
3. What were the people shouting? (Hosanna)
4. Do you know what Hosanna means? (Save, rescue)
5. When the religious leaders saw that there were many following Jesus, they felt \_\_\_\_\_ (Jealous)

**Craft:** Draw or print out a palm leaf. Get child to colour/paint/decorate it or if they are older, they can write the scripture verse on it. Cut it out and practice saying the memory verse while waving your palm branch!
