Questions:

1. In the end, Gideon had a \_\_\_\_\_ army. A. Small B. Large (A.small)

4. Gideon didn't feel special but God called him to lead a battle and win. Do you know that God has special things planned for you as well?! We can trust what God says and not be afraid!
5. What are some ways God talks to us? -through prayer -through the Bible - through other people -through being outside in His creation -through dreams

Craft:

Younger ages-

Parents-draw a picture of a jar and trumpet on a paper. Have kids decorate them with any supplies you may have at home, and cut them out if they are old enough. Get them to repeat the memory verse over and over with you. They are amazing at memorizing!!!!

Older kids-

Write the memory verse on a piece of paper. Underneath, write 'I will not fear...' and then write things that you may be fearful of or have been fearful of in the past. Then at the bottom in big letters write I WILL TRUST GOD! Put the paper in your room or somewhere you can see it this week and every time you see it read it and remember that God is bigger than any of our fears!
